#### DIRECTIONS

##### From Walnut Creek, Pleasant Hill Area

Take 680 North to 242 North and exit Solano-Grant Street. Turn right off exit. Go to 4th light and turn left on Bonafacio. Turn left into parking garage. Take stairs or elevator to 3rd floor. We are Suite 355 (to the right as you exit elevator)

##### From Martinez, Benecia Area

Take Interstate 4 East to 242 South, then follow above directions.

##### From Antioch, Pittsburg Area

Take Interstate 4 East to 242 South and take first exit Solano-Grant Street. Turn left off exit. Go to 5th light and turn left on Bonafacio. Turn left into parking garage. Take stairs or elevator to 3rd floor. We are Suite 355 (to the right as you exit elevator)

##### From Concord, Clayton Area

Take Clayton Road to downtown Concord. Clayton Road becomes Port Chicago Highway. Go several lights and turn left on Bonafacio. Go approximately 100 yards and turn right into parking garage. Take stairs or elevator to 3rd floor. We are Suite 355 (to the right as you exit elevator)

## About Our Doctor

Doctor Iranmanesh grew up in the South Bay. He attended UC San Diego where he completed his Bachelor's degree in Biology with minors in Philosophy and Psychology. Dr. Iranmanesh simultaneously completed two rigorous courses of study at the Harvard School of Dental Medicine and the Harvard School of Public Health. He obtained his Master's in Public Health (MPH) with an emphasis in health care management, as well as his Doctor of Dental Medicine (DDS) in 1997.

After the completion of his dental training, he finished a one year internship at the Massachusetts General Hospital in the department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. He was a resident in the department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the University of California in San Francisco where he began an intensive six year program. His training included a full year of general surgery, advanced training in microsurgery, as well as hospital anesthesia. In 2001, Dr. Iranmanesh obtained his medical degree (MD) and formally completed his training in 2004 at the University of California San Francisco.

Dr. Iranmanesh is currently an active member of the Contra Costa Dental Society. His affiliations include the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, the California Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, the California Dental Association, and the Contra Costa Dental Society. Dr. Iranmanesh is board certified through the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons.

His clinical interests include dentoalveolar surgery, anesthesia, and implant dentistry. He is currently on staff at John Muir Walnut Creek Campus and the Mt. Diablo Hospital in Concord.

## Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery

Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery is the intersection of medicine, dentistry, and surgery. It is the dental specialty that deals with surgical procedures of the teeth, jaws, and associated facial structures. We treat patients who suffer from conditions, defects, and injuries relating to the teeth, upper and lower jaws, and face. Oral surgeons must complete at a minimum 4 years of post-dental school training.

Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons treat and manage patients who suffer from discomfort related to wisdom teeth, facial pain, and misaligned jaws. We also perform reconstructive surgery for accident or trauma patients and those suffering from cysts or tumors. We offer a variety of surgical reconstructive options including placement of implants and related bone grafting. Our advanced training in anesthesia allows for your maximum comfort in our office setting.

## Dental Implants

Patients are often embarrassed by their missing teeth and are frustrated by the discomfort and inconvenience of dentures. They often complain of difficulty with eating and are bothered by their appearance. Dental implants are changing the lives for many of these patients who have lost one or more teeth. Developed more than 40 years ago by Dr. Per-Ingvar Branemark in Sweden, implants have opened the door to a lifetime of comfort and satisfaction by replacing lost teeth and thereby allowing optimal esthetics and function. By looking and feeling natural, implants offer renewed self-confidence and peace of mind.

Dental implants are small titanium posts that act as a tooth root substitute. They serve as the foundation for building a new smile. Implants help preserve facial structure and prevent bone deterioration. With precise surgical placement and adequate time for healing, they bond to the bone, creating a strong foundation for the replacement teeth. Once implants are placed and restored, they can serve you for many years to come. Good oral hygiene and regular appointments with your general dentist will ensure their longevity. To get the best possible functional and esthetic outcome, we work closely with your dentist in order to coordinate and customize your care.

## Appointments & Consultations

A presurgical consultation is necessary for many procedures and for all patients requiring intravenous or general anesthesia. The purpose of the initial consultation is to give you the opportunity to meet Dr. Iranmanesh and his staff, to review your medical and dental history, and most importantly to discuss your surgery. We will make every effort to perform your surgery the same day. You may be able to expedite your meeting by bringing with you your x-rays, a copy of your referral form from your dentist, and a list of all your current medications.

For your convenience, we offer appointments every weekday. We always strive to stay on time and we minimize your wait by scheduling appropriately. However, we do accept emergencies and do all we can to have you seen and treated on the same day. Your time is valuable and for your comfort, we offer free wireless internet access as well as refreshments.
